

2023 Garbage Collection Schedule

- There are 2 types of garbage collection points: a "burnable / non-burnable" and a "resources" collection point.
- The collection point is managed with the cooperation of local residents. Please verify the garbage collection points with those in your neighborhood.
- Garbage must be taken out by 8 am on the designated day (do not take out at night).

- * There will be no garbage collection on Saturdays, Sundays, and the New Year's Holiday (December 31st to January 3rd).
- * If a collection date other than the above falls on a national holiday, collection will be carried out as usual.
- * Oversized garbage cannot be put out at the collection point.
- * When you dispose of burnable and non-burnable garbage, please use Kodama-gun designated bags.
- * Please be sure to separate garbage properly and do your best to reduce the amount of garbage.

Note:

- Some items, such as **automobile parts**, **agricultural waste**, and **construction waste** cannot be accepted.
- Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators (freezers)) **cannot** be put out at the garbage collection point.
- Small home appliances are electronic devices that are not subject to the above Home Appliance Recycling Law.
- When disposing of PCs, please dispose of them as base collection or box collection, or contact the PC manufacturer.



■ Disposal of Garbage ■

Types	Contents	Other Information
Burnable Garbage	Kitchen garbage, paper, disposable diapers, plastics, vinyl bags (except those used for agricultural purposes), etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Place garbage in the designated Kodama-gun Burnable Garbage bags ◆ Please drain the water ◆ If any of the garbage does not fit into the designated bag, please take it to the Koyamagawa Clean Center or request collection.
Non-Burnable Garbage	Tableware, metal goods, umbrellas, small household appliances, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Place garbage in the designated Kodama-gun Non-Burnable garbage bags ◆ For cans that held food, please remove the contents and rinse the cans. ◆ Please wrap broken glass in paper before putting it in the bag.
Hazardous Waste (Twice a year)	Florescent Lights  Dry-Cell Batteries Thermometer (with Mercury) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Please remove from bag or box ◆ Light bulbs (besides fluorescent tube types) are considered Non-Burnable garbage. ◆ Please put broken fluorescent tubes in non-burnable garbage. ◆ The collection site will be announced in the Kamikawa Town monthly informational packet.

Garbage that doesn't fit in the designated bags are considered Oversized Garbage. Information is in the next section.

■ Fluorescent Light bulbs ■

With the exception of days when hazardous garbage is collected, fluorescent light bulbs will only be collected at the Disaster Prevention Environmental Division window inside the Kamiizumi General Branch Office.

■ Oversized Garbage ■

Some items cannot be accepted, so please check beforehand.

You will need an identity verification document, such as your driver's license, residence card, etc. to confirm your address in Kodama-gun.

Request Collection

(A contractor will come to your home to collect the garbage. However, they will not need to enter the building.)

Application: To have oversized garbage collected, please go to the public office information desk at Kamikawa City Hall or the General Branch Office. Fill out the application form at least one week before the collection day and pay the fee according to the item. You will receive a collection sticker which can be used for up to 5 items for the next collection service.

The garbage will be picked up at your residence.

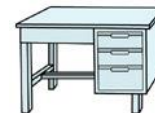
How to separate Recyclable Waste	
Cans	<p>○Beverage Cans: Items with recycling mark</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please dispose of food cans as Non-Burnable Garbage • Aluminum and steel cans do not need to be separated <p>※Please separate in areas where recyclables are being collected</p>
Bottles	<p>○Beverage bottles..... Large Sake bottles(1.8L)、 Beer bottles</p> <p>○Other beverage bottles.... Please wash and separate other bottles from those listed above.</p> <p>○Broken bottles..... Please dispose with non-burnable garbage</p>
P.E.T Bottles	<p>○Items with PET recycle mark</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean the bottle and remove the label • Please dispose of caps, colored bottles, translucent bottles, and very dirty bottles as Burnable garbage
Spray Cans	<p>○Dispose of spray cans (cassette cylinders, pesticides, hairspray, paint, etc.) after they've been completely used up.</p> <p>※Please do not make any holes and remove the cap</p>



Note: When disposing of cans and bottles, please empty and rinse thoroughly with water

※ Dispose of metal caps as Non-Burnable garbage and plastic caps as Burnable garbage.

★ Corrugated cardboard will not be collected if it is left at the collection location. Please put the cardboard in a burnable garbage bag and dispose with other burnable garbage.



■ Collective Resource Recovery ■

Some resources, such as used paper, used cloth, cans, and bottles are collected by local recycling organizations (PTA, administrative districts, etc.) Please contact the relevant organization for the collection date and location.

※ Collection boxes for items such as empty cans are managed locally.

To promote garbage reduction measures, Kamikawa Town gives incentive subsidies to authorized recycling groups. For more information, please contact the Public Office of Disaster Prevention and Environment Division at 0495-77-2124.

■ Disposing of Home Appliances ■



Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, washing machines, clothes dryers, refrigerators (freezers)) cannot be put out at the garbage collection point. Please dispose of it by one of the following methods.

○ Contact the dealer

There is a recycling and transportation fee. Please contact your dealer for more information.

○ Bring to designated pick-up location

After checking the manufacturer and model number, purchase a recycling ticket at the post office and bring it to the designated collection place. If you bring it yourself, there is no transportation fee.

○ Request Collection

Please purchase a recycling ticket at the post office and apply at the Kamikawa City Hall Disaster Prevention Environmental Division and at the Kamiizumi General Branch office with the ticket. (You cannot apply by phone.)

The fee is 500 yen up to 10 kg. If it exceeds 10 kg, it costs an additional 50 yen per 1 kg, so please check the weight in advance. In addition, home collection is also offered by Renet Japan Recycling Co., Ltd. Please visit the town website's homepage for more information.

Home appliances other than those listed above are subject to the Small Home Appliance Recycling Law.

Please put appliances in the collection box (for items that fit in the input port 15 cm x 30 cm) that is permanently installed on the 2nd floor of the Kamikawa City Hall 2nd Floor, in front of the Disaster Prevention Environmental Division (防災環境課) or inside Kamiizumi General Branch office.

For items that won't fit in the collection box, please bring to the locations listed above on the base collection dates (twice a year).
