

How to sort and place waste.

Properly sorted

Using the district and city designated bags

On the appointed collection day

Early in the morning by 8:00 a.m.

To a predetermined location

Burnable waste

Kitchen waste

Drain well

Plastic products

Diapers

Flush diaper feces down the toilet

Wood chips

Pruned branches and plants
Cut into pieces that will fit in the bag

How to place wastes

Use designated bags and take them to designated collection points
The mouth of the bag should be tied or taped

Non-burnable waste

Non-recyclable glass and ceramics

Plastics with metal parts

Metals

Cans for other than food and beverage

Cutting tools

Small home appliances

Please use small appliance collection as much as possible.
Small home appliances (15cm x 30cm or smaller) are also collected at collection boxes located at the town hall and facilities for multipurpose exchange facilities.

How to place wastes

Use designated bags and take them to designated collection points
The mouth of the bag should be tied or taped

Recyclable resources

Bottles

Returnable bottles

• 1.8L bottle for Sake
• Beer bottles

Other Bottles

• Dressing bottles
• Jam jars
• Energy drink bottles

Bottles that cannot be put out

Broken or cracked bottles should be placed of as non-burnable waste.

Cans that cannot be taken out

Cans other than for food and beverage, Spray cans, etc.

To Separate Collection Containers at designated collection points

●Cans do not need to be crushed
●Please do not separate steel and aluminum cans.

PET bottles

Only PET bottles with a recycle mark

Check this mark

PET Plastic bottles for beverages, soy sauce, mirin, and other seasonings

PET bottles that cannot be discarded

Please place items without the recycling mark (PET1) as burnable trash. Cooking oil, shampoo, etc.

To Separate Collection Containers at designated collection points

●Peel off "labels" and place them as in the burnable trash.

How to place wastes

●Empty the contents of the bottle and rinse it lightly with water.
●Remove crowns and caps from bottles and place them as noncombustible trash.
●Heavily soiled cans and bottles, rusty cans, and broken bottles should be placed as noncombustible trash.
●Take heavily soiled plastic bottles to the burnable trash.
●Please remove caps from PET bottles and place them as burnable trash.

Spray cans and cassette cylinders

Spray cans and cassette cylinders

Please be sure to use up the contents, vent the gas and put it in the basket without making any hole.

How to place wastes

Discard in the blue basket at the designated collection points

Hazardous waste

Mercury-containing thermometers

Bulky wastes

Collection day (2nd Wednesday)
Application deadline (1st Wednesday)

Kamikawa Town collects bulky wastes upon request in order to place them for its proper disposal. Bulky wastes are not collected at garbage collection area, so never put them at the garbage collection area.

Desks
Furniture such as chests and drawers
Chairs/ Bicycles
Carpets, Futon or padded mattress for bedding
Washing machines
Refrigerators, Air conditioners

Collection upon request

Upon application, Bulky waste is collected at your home address and transported directly. Please put it in front of your house by 8:30 in the morning of the collection date.

How to apply

Reception desk

Please apply directly at the counter of the Disaster Prevention and Environmental Division or the Community Development Division.
After the fee is paid at the counter, you will receive the sticker shown in the right. Please write your name in the sticker, put it on the bulky waste and put it in front of your house in the collection date morning.

Reception time: 8:30 - 17:15 (excluding national holidays and Year-end and New Year's holidays)

Up to five items can be accepted at one application. (not five types)
