

# Disposing of Household Garbage

- Please put out the specified items on the specified days.
- Please take out your trash before 8:00 AM on the day of collection.
- Please use Kodama County City certified trash bags for burnable and non-burnable garbage.



Let's follow the included rules and take out the trash properly!

## How to Dispose of Garbage

Type	Contents	Other Information
Burnable Garbage	Kitchen waste, paper, disposable diapers (excluding waste), plastics, vinyl bags (excluding agricultural waste), etc. 	• Please put all burnable garbage in Kodama-gun certified burnable trash bags. • Please properly drain kitchen waste. • <b>PET bottles should be disposed of as recyclable garbage, not burnable.</b>
Non-Burnable Garbage	Tableware, metal goods, umbrellas, small electrical appliances, etc. 	• Please put all non-burnable garbage in Kodama-gun certified non-burnable trash bags. • For food cans, please remove the contents and rinse before disposal. • Please wrap broken glass in paper before disposal, to prevent risk. • <b>Empty beverage cans should be disposed of as recyclable garbage, not non-burnable garbage.</b>
Recyclables	• Beverage Cans • Bottles • PET Bottles • Spray Cans  (Cassette cylinders, lacquer, hairspray, etc.) 	• Beverage Cans... Items with a recycling mark. Aluminum cans and steel cans do not need to be separated. (Please separate in areas where recyclables are being collected.) • Bottles... Large sake bottles (1.8 liters), beer bottles. • Other Bottles... Please wash and separate other bottles from those listed above. • PET Bottles... Please clean the bottle and remove the label. Please dispose of translucent, colored, or very dirty bottles burnable garbage. • Spray Cans... Please remove the cap, make sure all contents have been used, and do not make any holes in the can. • For details on how to dispose of recyclables, please see the back of this document.  [ NOTE ] • Please wrap any broken in glass in paper or cloth before disposal. Broken glass should be disposed of as non-burnable garbage. • Please dispose of colored bottles or very dirty bottles as burnable garbage. • Metal caps should be disposed of as non-burnable garbage. Plastic caps should be disposed of as burnable garbage. • Cardboard will not be collected, even if taken to the collection site. • If you must dispose of cardboard, please put it in a Kodama certified burnable garbage bag and dispose of it as burnable garbage.

Hazardous Waste	Dry-cell batteries, mercury thermometers, fluorescent tubes, small rechargeable batteries 	• On the collection date shown on the left, collection will be sent to the collection point of each administrative district. • The time and collection location will be announced through public relations and garbage sorting apps. • Bring it to the Disaster Prevention and Environment Division of the town hall or the Kamiizumi General Branch Office. • On days other than the collection days listed on the left, only fluorescent tubes can be brought to the window for collection.
Small Appliances	Landline telephones, mobile phones, fax machines, rice cookers, microwave ovens, fans, stoves, VCRs, radios, personal computers and accessories, vacuum cleaners, game consoles, electric sewing machines, etc. 	• Please put out on the date shown on the left • The time and collection location will be announced through public relations and garbage sorting apps. • Put it in a permanent collection box. • Please put it in the collection box (15 cm x 30 cm) permanently installed at the entrance of the town hall and multipurpose exchange facilities. • Courier collection by Linet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd. • Kamikawa Town has a partnership agreement with Linet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd., a certified business operator for small home appliance recycling. Apply here. 
Oversized Garbage	Desks, chests of drawers, carpets, futons, bicycles, etc. (Items which do not fit in a certified bag are oversized garbage. Oversized garbage cannot be left at the collection point.) 	• <b>Self Delivery to Koyamagawa Clean Center</b> Location: Koyamagawa Clean Center 151-1 Higashiikakko, Honjo ☎ 0495-22-8200 Hours: 8:40~12:00 13:00~16:30 Mondays-Fridays Closed: Saturdays, Sundays, New Year's Holidays (December 31st-January 5th) Fee: 40 yen per kg • <b>Request Collection (2nd Wednesday of the month)</b> To have oversized garbage collected, please go to the Disaster Prevention and Environment Division / Kamiizumi General Branch Office and pay the service fee at least one week before the collection day. You will receive a collection sticker which can be used for up to 5 items for the next collection service. The fee will depend on the item.

## Koyamagawa Clean Center: Unacceptable Items

• Items subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law (TVs, air conditioners, washing machines and clothes dryers, refrigerators and freezers.)  
Please dispose of these items properly using the following methods.

- 1 Contact the dealer: Please contact the dealer for more information.
- 2 Bring it to the designated pick-up location: Please purchase a recycling ticket at the post office in advance and bring it to the designated collection place.  
Pick-Up Location: Kanto Seino Transport Co., Ltd. Honjo Branch 166-1 Unomori, Honjo City ☎ 0495-21-3311
- 3 Request Collection: Please purchase a recycling ticket at the post office in advance before applying.

• Agricultural materials • Tires • Steel frames • Fire extinguishers • Gas cylinders • Blocks

A fee will be charged according to the weight of the item, so please check the weight in advance.

• Bricks • Waste oil • Personal computers • Bowlingballs • Etc.

※ For personal computers, please use the small appliance collection method described above.

# ~How to Dispose of Recyclables~

Collection containers, such as those shown below, will be placed at the recyclables collection site on the day of collection. Are you disposing of bottles, PET bottles, beverage cans, and spray cans, which can be re-used as resources, as burnable or non-burnable garbage? If you mix them in with the rest of your garbage, they become garbage too. But if you dispose of them as recyclables, we can effectively use their resources. Thank you for your cooperation.
